

Rimbey Aquatic Centre saves Energy

The Town of Rimbey is proud to share that the Rimbey Aquatic Centre received an install of 2 Variable Frequency Drives (VFD's) / Flowmeters to our main pool circulation pump and slide pump. The install was in large part thanks to a grant from the Municipal Climate Change Action Centre (MCCAC). The project is a great energy saver and will ensure the Town is more fiscally responsible. The VFD's regulate a pump motor that usually runs at less than full speed and can cut down energy consumption over a motor running at constant speed for the same period. In addition, it eliminates the need for mechanical drive components, which also helps reduce overall costs. The install was completed prior to opening on June 18, 2021.
